## FAQ's - Student Ambassador Program

## What is the Student Ambassador Program about?

## Can international students apply?

Yes, the program is open to international students if they have attended the Wharton Summer Program and are currently in school. They must also have at least one semester of school remaining, after you graduate from the summer program.

# How long is the Student Ambassador Program? What is the time commitment?

Applications are offered on a rolling basis. The program will be for a minimum of 6 months and a maximum of 9 months. Students can re-apply after their term is over. It a very flexible program with minimal time commitment.

### What are the responsibilities of a student ambassador?

As a student ambassador, you're expected to do the following:

- Be a representative for BrainGain Magazine summer programs
- Help us to connect with your school and its activities
- Participate in our information seminars on summer programs in your school and share your KWHS experience
- Be a Buddy to students who have confirmed their participation and counsel them through their queries
- Engage with others and help promote the program through social media channels.
